

Meeting FAQs

Grove Park Inn — This historic resort sells out each weekend in summer. Make your room reservations immediately!

For room reservations, call **800.438.5800** and request **Group Code 68W2BM**. The room rate is \$199.00 per night without resort fees, taxes and parking (Valet and self parking available). Rates are based on single or double occupancy. There is an extra charge for additional person in the room. The discounted room rate is available until Friday, July 9, 2010, at 12:00 PM PST. Reservations will be accepted at the prevailing rate after this date if there is availability. **IMPORTANT NOTE: IF YOU DO NOT BOOK YOUR ROOM IN THE ASSOCIATION'S ROOM BLOCK YOU WILL BE CHARGED ADDITIONAL FEES FOR REGISTRATION.** Attendees who make outside hotel reservations other than with the Moulding Association's official hotel discount room block at the Grove Park Inn will be charged an **additional \$300.00 fee (\$400.00 late registration)**. The Moulding Association's hotel group room block pays for meeting space fees, set up charges by hotel staff for education sessions, etc. Those attendees who book outside of the block using **package deals (even package deals with the Grove Park Inn)** will need to pay the additional registration fees separately.

Transportation Information — Local Airport:

Asheville/Henderson Regional Airport (AVL) Estimated Time/Distance to Resort: 25 minutes

Shuttle Service or Taxi: Grove Park Inn does not offer shuttle service. **However**, call the hotel to arrange a car pick-up service or take a taxi from the airport. Estimated transportation fee: \$45.00 one way.

Food & Beverage Note: Full registration includes the Buddy Pairings Reception, two continental breakfasts for representatives, two lunches, and the Associate Night dinner.

Attire: Resort casual for all meeting functions during the day and resort evening for all functions held 6PM or after.

Weather: Asheville in August will average a high of 83 degrees during the day, and a low of 62 degrees. Pack a warm jacket or sweater for walking along the grounds at night.
